ARTICLE II - SCOPE OF APPLICATION

- 1. The Parties shall provide, in accordance with the provisions of this Treaty, mutual legal assistance in all matters relating to the investigation, prosecution and suppression of offences.
 - 2. Assistance shall include:
 - (a) exchanging information and objects;
 - (b) locating or identifying persons, objects and sites;
- (c) serving documents; and annual assumption as a serving
 - (d) taking the evidence of persons;
 - (e) executing requests for searches and seizures;
 - (f) providing documents and records.
 - This Treaty is intended solely for mutual legal assistance between the Parties.
