For a determination under Article 13(3) (Establishment and Conduct of Review Panel) of whether the matter is trade-related, the Party which has requested the Review Panel has the onus of establishing that the matter is trade-related. For a determination under Article 14(1)(c) (Review Panel Reports and Determinations) of whether the Party that is the object of the request has failed to comply with its obligations, the onus of establishing such non-compliance is on the Party which has requested the Review Panel and its case may be supplemented by any other information provided under Article 13(3)(c) (Establishment and Conduct of Review Panel).

9. A Review Panel may not release the final report other than to the Parties. Panellists may furnish separate opinions on matters that are not the subject of unanimous agreement. A Review Panel however may not disclose which panellists are associated with majority or minority opinions.
