THE DEPARTMENT OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS ANNOUNCED TODAY THAT HIS EXCELLENCY COMMODORE MARCELO AUBONE PRESENTED TO THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL HIS LETTERS OF CREDENCE AS AMBASSADOR EXTRAORDINARY AND PLENIPOTENTIARY OF ARGENTINA TO CANADA. THE CEREMONY TOOK PLACE AT GOVERNMENT HOUSE.

THE CHIEF OF PROTOCOL, MR H.F. FEAVER, PRESENTED THE AMBASSADOR TO THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL. MR. N.A. ROBERTSON, UNDER-SECRETARY OF STATE FOR EXTERNAL AFFAIRS, AND MR. J.F. DELAUTE, SECRETARY TO THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL (ADMINISTRATIVE), WERE IN ATTENDANCE ON THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL. THE AMBASSADOR WAS ACCOMPANIED BY MR. N. SILVA D'HERBIL, MINISTER, COMMODORE L.R. ALBORNOZ, AIR ATTACHE, COLONEL H.L. SCASSO, MILITARY ATTACHE, MR. L.N. CLARASO DE LA VEGA, SECOND SECRETARY, AND MR. J.C. ARLIA, ATTACHE.

COMMODORE AUBONE WAS BORN IN 1901. DURING HIS CAREER HE SERVED AS AIR ATTACHE IN LIMA, PERU. HE HAS BEEN ASSOCIATED WITH MANY PHASES OF AERONAUTICS AND WAS A FORMER PROFESSOR OF AIRCRAFT STRUCTURE AT THE UNIVERSITY OF LA PLATA. COMMODORE AUBONE SERVED ALSO AS DIRECTOR OF THE ZONDA AIR TRANSPORT COMPANY, ALUMINUM DIVISION (ARGENTINA) AND THE NATIONAL ENERGY EXECUTIVE BOARD. HE IS MARRIED AND HAS FOUR CHILDREN.
