HIS EXCELLENCY DR. IGNACIO LUIS ARCAYA, FOREIGN MINISTER OF VENEZUELA WHO IS NOW IN NEW YORK AS HEAD OF THE VENEZUELAN DELEGATION TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE UNITED NATIONS, WILL COME TO CANADA, ACCOMPANIED BY MRS. ARCAYA, ON WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 30, FOR A PRIVATE VISIT OF APPROXIMATELY SIX DAYS. AFTER VISITING MONTREAL HE WILL MAKE AN INSPECTION TOUR OF THE ST. LAWRENCE SEAWAY EN ROUTE TO OTTAWA.

WHILE IN OTTAWA THE FOREIGN MINISTER AND MRS. ARCAYA WILL BE GUESTS OF HIS EXCELLENCY THE AMBASSADOR OF VENEZUELA AND MRS. MANUEL EGANA. THE PRIME MINISTER AND MRS. DIEFENBAKER HAVE INVITED THEM TO LUNCH AT 24 SUSSEX DRIVE. THEY WILL VISIT TORONTO BEFORE LEAVING CANADA.
