## DIPLOMATIC APPOINTMENT

The Right Honourable Joe Clark, Secretary of State for External Affairs, announces the following diplomatic appointment:

Mr. William E. Sinclair (58), born in Goshen, Nova Scotia, as High Commissioner to Guyana.

Mr. Sinclair [BA, Dalhousie University, 1951] joined the Federal Government in 1957. From 1973 to 1976, he has served as Counsellor (Immigration) in London. In Ottawa, from 1977 to 1978, he was Director of Personnel Finance and Administration, Foreign Service, in the Department of Employment and Immigration Canada (CEIC); from 1978 to 1980; Director of Resource Management, Foreign Branch, (CEIC); and from 1980 to 1981, Director for Asia and Pacific Bureau (CEIC). Since 1981, he has been Counsellor (Immigration) in Hong Kong. Mr. Sinclair replaces Mr. J.R. MacLachlan who is returning to Ottawa.
