Chairman: Mr. A. H. Brown, former Deputy Minister of Labour and Director, Canada Branch, International Labour Office.

Vice Chairman: Mr. J. J. Quinlan, Q.C., Deputy Director of Investigation and Research, Department of the Registrar General. Formerly associated with the War-time Prices and Trade Board in the Toronto area.

Employee representatives: Mr. J. A. D'Aoust, appointed on nomination of C.L.C. Retired. Was formerly Vice-President of the United Papermakers and Paperworkers. Mr. Gerard Picard, appointed on nomination of C.N.T.U. Is president of National Metal Trades Federation (CNTU). Mr. A. H. Balch, appointed on nomination of the National Legislative Committee—International Railway Brotherhoods. Retired. Was formerly National Legislative Representative in Canada and Chief Agent for the Brotherhood
