

he receives three-fourths of all the votes cast, he shall be declared elected. If the candidate be rejected, the initiation fee shall be returned to him. Should a candidate, after election, fail, for three regular meetings, to come forward for initiation, he shall forfeit his membership, together with his initiation fee; *provided*, such delay is not caused by sickness or unavoidable absence from the city.

*Sec. 3.*—The initiation fee for membership in the Union shall be one (1) dollar.

*Sec. 4.*—Any printer presenting a clear and duly accredited “Card of Membership” from any Union under the jurisdiction of the “International Typographical Union” shall be admitted a member upon payment of half the regular initiation fee; *provided*, he deposits such card at a regular meeting of the Union, not later than one month after commencing work within its jurisdiction; *provided further*, he shall have been guilty of no acts in violation of the Constitution and By-Laws of this Union. This section shall apply also to persons depositing cards issued by this Union; it being understood that in every case the regular dues of twenty-five cents per month shall be paid from the date of the deposit of card.

*Sec. 5.*—The President shall administer the following obligation to all persons joining this Union, whether by card or otherwise, viz:—“I, [A. B.] hereby sincerely pledge my honor as a man, that I will not reveal any business or proceedings of any meeting of this Union; that I will, without equivocation or evasion, and to the best of my ability, so long as I remain a member thereof, abide by the
