

10th. Marched to Ripley, and encamped - - - - - 9 miles

11th. Marched to Godalmin, and encamped - - - - - 9 miles

12th. Marched to Petersfield, and encamped - - - - - 23 miles

A hard day's march, a very rough and sandy road, and several of the men were not able to march.

13th. Marched to Southsea common near Portsmouth, and encamped - 17 miles

Total 74 miles.

14th. Halted this day at Southsea common. ---
Three companies of the Train of Artillery encamped on the left of us.

15th. Marched to Portsmouth, embarked at eight in the morning, disembarked at Cowes at eight at night, and arrived at the camp on the King's Forest, near Newport, in the isle of Wight, at ten.

The 1st and 2d regiments (except two companies of the 2d) did not arrive till the next day, being obliged to lye on the water all night. ---
Found several regiments encamped here.

16th. Remained in the same camp.

17th, and
