desired, and to the discussion of which alone the meeting when called must confine itself. The Commanding Officer may at any time call the Officers together for the consideration of matters affecting the welfare of the Regiment.

The Adjutant to act as Secretary to all meetings, keeping the minutes thereof in the Regimental Book provided for this purpose. Officers always to appear in undress Uniform without Swords, at all meetings for Regimental purposes.

13. Mess Dinner will take place annually at such time as may be fixed at a meeting called for that purpose.

General Provisions.

- 1. Any person recommended for promotion or appointment in the Regiment will, previous to such recommendation, sign the Regimental Standing Orders and pay over to the Pay Master such Fee as may be required, producing for the information of the Commanding Officer Certificates to that effect from the Adjutant and Pay Master.
- 2. No Officer in command of a Company to call it out for any special parade or occasion, without having obtained proper authority for so doing.
- 3. An Annual General Inspection of the Arms, Accourrements and Clothing of the Regiment will
