The "Queen" will be devoted, during the season of 1891 exclusively to excursion traffic, for which she is admirably adapted. The round-trip rate from St. Paul, Minneapolis, Duluth or Ashland to Alaska, including hotel and steamer charges, is \$100.00. The "Queen" in making this round trip will be about twelve days—other steamers about fifteen days.

Passenger steamers will be found in the hands of general and traveling passenger agents of the Northern Pacific, who will reserve accommodations for its patrons, or parties may contract directly with Captain W. H. Clegg, of the "Queen," or Captain J. C. McLean, of the "Mexico" Railroad, at St. Paul, Minn.

The season extends from May 1st to October 1st. Tickets will be limited to one month's good time to Portland or Tacoma, stay days returning within said limit, the holder, however, to have tickets on or before October 1st.

An \$80 Round-Trip Excursion Ticket, St. Paul, Minneapolis, Duluth, West Superior, Superior or Ashland to Tacoma, Seattle, Portlau or Victoria, and return, is on sale at the railroads mentioned, and by all express agencies, for the round trip, including hotel and steamer charges, and for return, within limit of ticket. The above ticket sold any day to all applicants. Tickets will be issued at this rate out by the Northern Pacific to Victoria, and return to St. Paul, via Milwaukee, Chicago, and Milwaukee to St. Paul, without additional charge. Tickets will be issued at \$80 rate out via Milwaukee, Portlau, Victoria, and return to St. Paul, via Milwaukee, and return via Victoria, Portlau to St. Paul, and return to Victoria, Port Arthur.

**YELLOWSTONE NATIONAL PARK**

SEASON OF 1891, JUNE 1ST TO OCTOBER 1ST.

**\$10 TICKETS.**

On Sale at St. Paul, Minneapolis, Duluth, Minn., Ashland, Wis., Portland, Ore., and Tacoma, Wash., May 28th to September 26th; by eastern lines, May 29th to September 27th, covers the expense of the round trip from St. Paul, Minneapolis, Duluth, Ashland, or Milwaukee, to Livingston, and thence to Mammoth Hot Springs, via Billings, and return, including Northern Pacific, and two double berths in Pullman Sleeping Car, meal at Northern Pacific Dining Cars, and at Hotel Albermarle at Livingston, Mont., stage transportation from Livingston to Mammoth, and accommodations at the Park Association hotels.

Tourists holding the \$10 and \$100 tickets, and desiring to go to Yellowstone, will be allowed \$10 additional at Mammoth Hot Springs Hotel.

Limit of ticket, forty days, i.e., need going thirty days, returning ten days. All tickets, however, must be used in the Park before October 6th.

Stop-over will be allowed within said limit of ticket at Billings, or any point en route between St. Paul and the Park, and return to St. Paul, or Portland, or Tacoma. The upper portion of ticket, and the signed and stamped at Mammoth Hot Springs Hotel, and presented on main line train for return passenger within said limit of ticket, and return to St. Paul.

When the ticket is created at the pleasure of tourists within final limit of ticket, the only additional expense being for hotel accommodations.

**\$12.50, \$40 AND \$50 TICKETS.**

On Sale at Livingston, Mont., May 31st to September 30th, both dates inclusive.

The \$12.50 Ticket includes railroad and stage fares Livingston to Mammoth Hot Springs and return, and one and one-quarter days' round-trip excursion to Mammoth, Lower Geyser Basin, Norris, Grand Canyon and Falls of the Yellowstone, Lower and Upper Geyser Basins and return, and five and one-quarter days' accommodation at Mammoth.

The \$40 Ticket includes railroad and stage fares Livingston to Mammoth Hot Springs, Norris, Grand Canyon and Falls of the Yellowstone, Lower Geyser Basin, Norris, and Upper Geyser Basin, via Norris, Lower and Midway Geyser Basins, and return, and five and one-quarter days' accommodation at Mammoth.

The \$50 Ticket Good if used between June 1st and October 6th, inclusively.

No stamping of these tickets required at any point in the Park.

**\$50 ROUND-TRIP TICKETS.**

On Sale at St. Paul, Minneapolis, Duluth, Minn., and return, will be on sale of point named May 28th to September 28th.

Limit forty days, good going thirty days, returning ten days. The return portion of ticket must be signed and stamped at Livingston and presented on train, and the portion of ticket of same date.

Stop-over allowed within limits of ticket.

A Daily Stage Line.—The Park Association will run a daily line of stages during the entire season, in both directions, between the following points, i.e., Chama, the terminus of the North, to Pocatello, Idaho, via Cheyenne, Wyoming, and St. Paul, and return, good going thirty days, including Mammoth Hot Springs, Norris, Upper Geyser Basin, and Yellowstone Lake, via Grand Canyon.
