

whom shall form a quorum. The Secretary and Treasurer to hold office during the pleasure of the Executive Committee, and to have three months' notice previous to his being dismissed from office, except in case of misdemeanor or neglect of duty, and to give a similar notice in case of his wishing to resign.

3.—It shall be the duty of the President to preside at all meetings of the officers of the Association; or, in his absence, the Vice-President shall preside *pro. tem.*

4.—The Secretary and Treasurer shall receive all monies for the Association, and pay the same subject to the order of the Executive Committee. He shall keep a true record of all the business proceedings of the Association, and shall register the names of all the members in a book provided for that purpose, and make a correct half-yearly report of all the receipts and expenditures, number of members, and condition of the Association, which shall be sent to each member. The fiscal year of the Association shall end on the 27th day of December in each year.

5.—The Secretary and Treasurer shall give security to the amount of \$2,000 for the faithful performance of his duties.

6.—There shall be an Executive Committee, to consist of six members, to whom all applications for membership shall be referred, and if not approved of by them, the advance fee shall be refunded. No claim will be recognized unless accompanied by medical certificate, or some other satisfactory evidence, of the death, or dis-
