GENESEE COMING IN TOW

Rochester's Cup Challenger Meets
With Accident While Cross-
ing the Lakes.

WILL MAKE PORT THIS MORNING.

Crew Will Arrive on Monday—Close
of the L. Y. R. A. Regatta—
Cruising Race To-Day.

Mr. Dyer's steam yacht that arrived at
the R.C.Y.C. last night passed the chal-
lenger Genesee about half way across the
lake, being forced by the Chicago steam
yacht Pathfinder. The Genesee was struck
by a small boat quarter way, and
had her port shroud carried away. She will
arrive in port early this morning.

About 2 o'clock yesterday the boat was
anchored near the Rochester Yacht Club
house for the first time since she has been
sailed and repaired. Skipper Davis and
the balance of the crew boarded the craft
and at once set to work repairing the
damage and carrying for the numerous details
preparatory to taking the boat out for a
trial cruise. The boat hoisted her new
mainsail made by Wilson & Sibby. The
mainsail hoist was off and the Genesee
would have arrived here at noon yesterday
but for the accident. A number of "bunks
and a varied assortment of cooking utensils
were placed on board, and this extra
load made necessary the removal of the
siphon boat.

J. H. Hanley, the manufacturer of the
Genesee, carefully examined the boat be-
fore it was sent down the slide, preparatory
to its start on its long journey across
the lake. Hanley will accompany the
crew to Toronto. They will reach here
Monday morning.
