ARRESTS MADE IN STRATHROY ROBBERIES

Four Men Brought To County Jail Friday Night.

Chief of Police Wilson of Strathroy, arrested four men at that place in connection with several recent thefts in that town, and they were last night brought to the county jail here, having been committed for trial Friday by Magistrate R. M. Freeman of Strathroy.
