BURGLAR PROOF SAFE.—In his efforts to produce a Burglar Proof Safe, the inventor has evidently made a long stride in the right direction. This Safe is no copy of those in general use, but is quite original; the outer shell or frame (with well-rounded corners), being one continuous band of iron and steel welded together at the ends; the front and back being secured to this shell in a remarkably strong and ingenious manner. All the bolting is done from the inside, and the points of the steel bolts are hardened. Taken as a whole, it is the most formidable obstacle ever placed between the "burglar" and his coveted treasure. We recommend the award of a gold medal.
