

Spokane, Wash., Aug. 11—A portable telephone that weighs only two and a half pounds is part of the equipment of every forest ranger in the Spokane country this year. The field set was invented by R. B. Adams of Missoula, Mont, ed by R. B. Adams of Missoula, Monty forest officer, and replaces a set that weighs ten pounds. The new instrument with a few feet of wire, can be carried easily by the ranger, and makes it possible for him to get in touch instantly with a supervisor or district ranger over many miles of forest service wires throughout the national forests. To talk over the lines the ranger merely through his emergency wire over the telephon line and connects the two ends with the portable instrument, and the instrument is then connected with the ground wire, the end of which must be thrust is damp earth or water. Instead of ringing a bell in the receiving station, the connection causes a screeching sound from a small megaphone shaped apparatus known as the "Howler." The portable telephones are valuable in all emergencies, especially in reporting fires.
