James Perrott Prince, born in St. John
in 1878, died on April 30 in Durban,
South Africa, at the age of seventy-seven
years. His family were Loyalists who
settled here after the revolutionary war
but he, after completing his medical
course at the University of New York
and commencing practice in New York
city became an American citizen. He
volunteered for service as a surgeon in
the American civil war and for a time
was a prisoner of war. He was associated
with some of the most distinguished men
on both sides. After the war he removed to South Africa where he was
medical adviser to Cecil Rhodes and was
in practice for a time with Dr. Sir Starr
Jameson, of Jameson's raid fame. During
the Kaffir Rebellion of 1877 he raised
and commanded a troop of horse. For
several years he was United States consul at Durban. He is survived by his
wife, one daughter and a son who is
now on active service. He was buried
with international honors.)
