LABOR OPPOSES FRONTIER CHANGES INSPIRED BY DESIRE OF CONQUEST. Paris, March 8—The managing committee of the general labor federation has adopted a resolution which condemns any rectification of frontiers which is inspired by desire of conquest and opposes armed intervention in Russia.

Responsibility is declined according to the resolution, for "social events which may occur in case the French delegates at the peace conference systematically disregard popular aspirations and the desire of the laboring classes, which are those of humanity as a whole."

HUN ESPIONAGE STILL WORKING. Berno, March 8—(French Wireless Service)—The Czechoslovak government, in its investigations of the activities of the German vice-consul Schwartz, who was arrested several days ago, has learned that Schwartz was the active worker in Bohemia in a plan to provoke disorders in German Bohemia and Moravia. MINISTERS WILL CONFER TOMORROW ON HARBOR PLAN

R. A. Wigmore, M. P., and Commissioner Bullock Return Today With News of Negotiations at Ottawa.

Hon. Frank B. Carvell, minister of public works, and Hon. C. C. Ballantyne, minister of marine, will confer tomorrow (Sunday) in Montreal, where Hon. Mr. Ballantyne is convalescing, and come to a definite decision concerning the nationalization of the port of St. John.

Before Sunday night, or not later than Monday forenoon, the result of the conference of federal ministers will be telegraphed to R. W. Wigmore, M. P., who returned today from Ottawa, accompanied by Commissioner T. H. Bullock, and by Mayor R. T. Hayes, Messrs. Bullock and Wigmore have been engaged for several days at the Dominion capital getting the important harbor matter straightened out.

The price which is confidently expected by the St. John delegation is \$2,200,000. A claim for \$380,000, which is a capitalization of harbor fees for the next five years, is being debated, but another claim of \$75,000 for Partridge Island is being willingly allowed.

The \$380,000 claim, the anticipated revenue for the next five years capitalized at five per cent, and the same basis of calculation was employed, arriving at the Partridge Island claim for \$75,000.

Hon. Mr. Carvell is debating the equity and business precedent of the harbor fee claim of \$380,000, and the St. John representatives are not exactly obdurate in pressing it.

SOME INDUSTRIES WILL REDUCE STAFFS

Ottawa, March 8—The employment service of the department of labor reports that, for the week ending February 22, employment returns were received from 1,561 firms in Quebec, New Brunswick, Nova Scotia, Prince Edward Island and Ontario. The total number of persons on the pay rolls of these firms on February 22 was 168,137, and the number of persons anticipated to be on the pay roll on March 1 was 166,806, a reduction of 1,331 or .791 per cent.
