

- A.218 fact? Search your memory. This is a very serious matter. Before I went down that day I was given to understand that I would get the vehicle.
- Q.219 Yes. Several days before you had spoken to Captain Jessop. Isn't that right?
- A.219 I don't remember.
- Q.220 You don't remember. Well, am I right in this, that on the Wednesday the Twenty-Seventh or the Twenty-Eighth - I don't care, either one of those dates, you saw Corporal Tengum.
- A.220 Yes sir.
- Q.221 Are you sure it wasn't several days before that you saw Captain Jessop?
- A.221 No sir.

The Prosecutor declines to re-examine the witness.

The witness is questioned by the Judge Advocate:

- Q.222 When you talk of Captain Jessop, do you see him in court here?
- A.222 Yes sir.
- Q.223 Where is he?
- A.223 Right there sir. (Witness indicates the accused)
- Q.224 Where were these tires taken from?
- A.224 Around the back of the Tech Stores in the garage.
- Q.225 Were they new tires?
- A.225 I believe they were old ones sir.
- Q.226 When - what kind of vehicle tires were they?
- A.226 They were jeep tires, sir.

The witness is questioned by the Court:

- Q.227 Did anyone point then out to you?
- A.227 Corporal Tengum got them. He knew where they were, sir.
- Q.228 Were there any other tires there?
- A.228 He carried them out - they were in a sort of a little alley-way sir. He carried them out and put them in the jeep.
- Q.229 Were there other tires in the stores?
- A.229 They were not in the stores sir. They were in a sort of little alcove. I don't think there was any more tires there in that spot.
- Q.230 Was it a normal place to keep tires?
- A.230 I think so sir. They were just thrown in there sir.
- Q.231 Was it a locked-up building?
- A.231 No sir.
- Q.232 Was it a normal place to keep tires?
- A.232 I would say it was a normal place to keep tires.
- Q.233 Is there any other place for tires?
- A.233 No sir.
- Q.234 Had you directly asked Captain Jessop some days before for a jeep?
- A.234 I asked my troop officer.
- Q.235 Who was your troop officer?
- A.235 Lieutenant
- Q.236 What did your troop officer say at the time?
- A.236 He said he thought it could be arranged.
