THE "CANADA FIRST" PARTY.

Who constitute the Party—its origin, origin and growth—its Club and Club House—The Aristocratic Leaders of a Democratic People—This is a large number of persons within this Province—its well as out of it—to whom the words "Canada First" are an end in themselves.
