Dear Sir:

I am advised by the Highwood Sarcos Oils Limited that arrangements have been made with Mr. F. P. Byrne (Anglo-Canadian Oils) to carry out a drilling programme on the area held under lease by the Company. The proposals contemplate the drilling of the first well on Section 20, Township 23, Range 4. The exact location of this well has not yet been decided upon but I hope to be in possession of this information in a couple of days. This development contemplates the construction of a road from the Bragg Creek road to the location and also the laying of a gas line from the north end of the Turner Valley development to the location, together with the installation of a small pumping plant and water line from the Elbow River to the location. The details of this development will be furnished at a later date.
