MEMO.

I, Stephen Elliott, Sr, a member of the Chippewa of Nawash Band of Indians, residing on Cape Croker Reserve, in the Province of Ontario, hereby make oath and say that I am the son and heir of the late, Abner Elliott, who owned certain lands on Seugog Island, in the Province of Ontario, and hereby register my claim to such lands which are illegally being held by certain families of Indians, who do not own such lands and are occupying the same as squatters.
