

Probate for Co. Westmorland, N. B., since 1823. Is President of the Albert and Westmorland Mining and Manufacturing Co. Was Clerk of the Peace for the same Co., from 1823 until 1862. Was a mem. of the Ex Council, N. B., from 1844 to 1858. Sat for Westmorland in House of Assembly, N. B., from 1827 until 1836, when he was appointed to the Leg. Council, where he sat until called to the Senate of the Dominion in May, 1867. Was a delegate to England in 1833, on behalf of the House of Assembly, on important public business; again a second time, in 1852, on behalf of the Government, on the subject of the Intercolonial Railway; and again in 1866 on behalf of the Government on the subject of the Union of the Colonies. Was also at various times sent by the Government as a delegate on public business to Washington, Toronto, Quebec and Halifax. Was a mem. of the Charlottetown and Quebec Union Conferences in 1864.—*Dorchester, N. B.*
