B. in Yorkshire, Eng., in 1841, and came with his father to Queensbury, York Co., in 1849. M. Mary Ann Annett of Fredericton. Carries on a farming, lumbering and milling business. Has been a Councillor and Warden of his Co. First returned to Ho. of Assem. at g. e., 1892, and re-elected at g. e., 1895. A Conservative.—*Temperance Vale*.

PITTS, HERMANN H. (York).

Ancestors came from England and settled in United States, whence they removed to St. John, N.B., about the time of the arrival of the Loyalists. B. at Oromocto, 16th July, 1858. Ed. at the Collegiate School, Fredericton. M. 1884, dau. of Cosmo F. McLeod, merchant, Springfield. Is Editor of the *New Brunswick Reporter*. Is Grand Worthy Assoc. of Sons of Temperance and Grand Master for N.B. of the Loyal Orange Assoc. First returned to Ho. of Assem. at g. e., 1892, and re-elected at g. e., 1895. A Conservative.—*Fredericton, N. B.*

PORTER, JAMES E. (Victoria).

Father, John Porter, was among the first settlers on the Upper St. John River. B. in 1847. Ed. at the Academy at Presque Isle. M. Alma J. Watson. Is engaged in farming and milling, and has been a mem. of the Municipal Council for 24 years, and Warden of his Co. for 10 years. An unsuccessful candidate at g. e., 1886; first returned at by-elections held in 1889; was not a candidate at g. e., 1892; re-elected at g. e., 1895. A Liberal.—*Andover*.

RICHARD, AMBROSE D., LL.B. (Westmoreland).

Of French Acadian descent. S. of David Richard and Julie Ouelette. B. at Memramcook, N.B., 5 Feb., 1850. Ed. at St. Joseph Coll. there, and at St. Dunstan's Coll., Charlottetown, P.E.I. Graduated at Boston Univ., and obtained the degree of LL.B., 4 June, 1879. Called to the Bar, N.B., 23 June, 1879. M., 1 Oct., 1884, Miss Lizzie V. Holt, of Memramcook. Was elected to the Municipal Council of Westmoreland, Co. of Dorchester, 25 Oct., 1879, and has been a Commr. in and for the Co. of Westmoreland, under ch. 38 and 43 Con. Stat. N.B.; was a mem. of the Leg. Council from 20 May, 1882, until the abolition of that Chamber. Apptd. Solicitor Gen. 1892, but an unsuccessful candidate at g. e., 1892. First returned to Ho. of Assem. at g. e., 1895. A Conservative.—*Dorchester N.B.*
