10 rection of the said Company, and within the time to be limited by the said Justice, and in default thereof the offender to be committed to the Common Gaol of the District where such offence shall have been committed, for

XX. And be it enacted, That the fines Fines, how levied. and forfeitures authorized to be summarily imposed by this Act, shall and may be levied

and collected by distress and sale of the
20 offender's goods and chattels, under the authority of any Warrant or Warrants of Distress for that purpose to be issued by the Justice before whom the conviction shall have been had; and in case there shall be

25 no goods or chattels to satisfy such Warrant or Warrants, such offender or offenders shall and may be committed to the Common Gaol of the District for any period not exceeding
month Imprisonment for want of distress.

30 XXI. And be it enacted, That if any person or persons shall, after proceeding on any such road with any waggon, carriage Penalty on persons turning out of road to evade toll. or other vehicle, or animals liable to pay toll,

turn out of the said road into any other road,
35 and shall enter the said road beyond any of the said gate or gates without paying toll, whereby such payment shall be evaded, such person or persons shall, for every such offence, forfeit and pay the sum of

40 shillings, which said sum shall be expended on the said road or towards the discharge of any debts due by any such Company; and any one Justice of the Peace for the District in which such part of the said road is situate,
