## 'People concerned about peace' letter unrealistic

To the Editor:

This letter is in response to Deborah Wayne's "People concerned about peace" letter published in the March 13, 1981 edition of the Brunswickan. It's analogies and rhetoric are so far out of touch with reality that they should be commented on.

The mindless slaughter of the Hitler government have little or no place in a discussion of the violence in El Salvador. To attempt to make North Americans feel "guilty" for supporting a mildly repressive regime there, against the possibility of victory by persons representing an extremist totalitarian system of government is unjustifiable. The US

has never fostered or condoned the murder of innocents committed by the fanatics of the Far Right in El Salvador. What the U.S. has attempted to do is support the only moderate force involved in the political turmoil there; the present Decarte government. By trying to defeat Soviet-supplied insurgents in El Salvador, the U.S. is charting a course that might end the threat of takeover by the extreme left or right. The pressure for and justification given for a right-wing coup in that country, by members of the far-right, has always been the immediate threat of the Cuban-backed guerrillas.

Left to its own devices, the Salvadoran government which

still has a chance to reconcile the peasantry of El Salvador to its reforms, (without the pressures and fears caused by Castro's legions) might steer that nation towards the respectable goals exhibited by former fascist dictatorships such as Spain (which just recently rejected a coup by the right with a clear voice). Deprived of American military and economic aid, the nation of El Salvador could be on the road to a Communist engineered victory and system of government.

What Communist states in recent (or any) years have "reformed" under Soviet

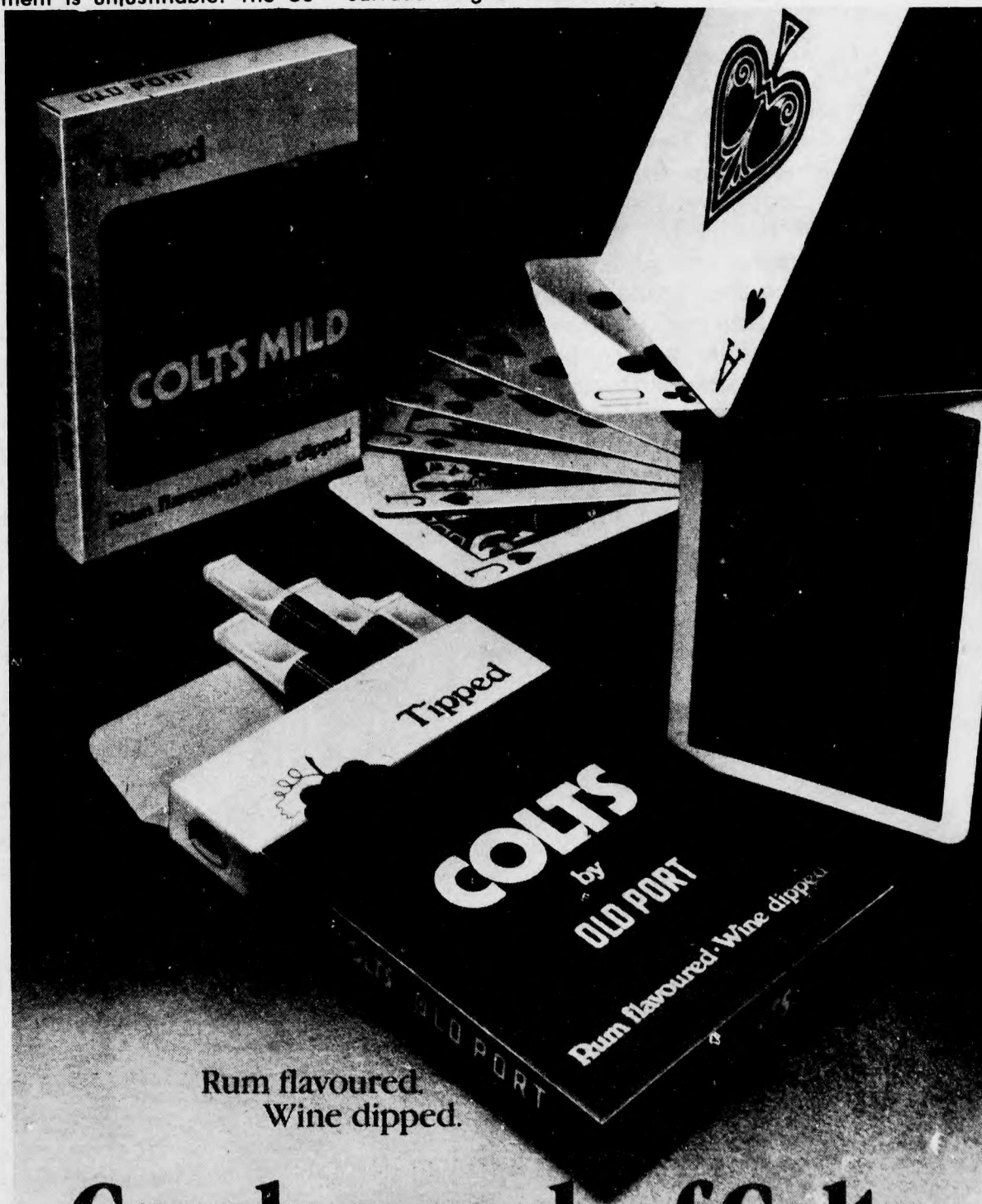
