Say to our good Father that we have a small place of worship erected on the Isle aux Allumettes, where one of our Missionaries from the Lake of the Two Mountains generally resides during a month or two in the summer season. This Brother is all we have to say at present. You see our miserable situation and will no doubt make it fully known. —

Under the circumstances stated, we humbly pray, that our good Father the Governor General will be pleased to grant us an early answer to our petition above mentioned. Now the Chief Scaondimukitch concluded his speech with the usual thanks to the Officers present.
