Sir,-

In connection with application of the Vancouver Power Company for Right of Way through the Matsqui Main and Matsqui Sahacum Indian Reserves, B. C., I beg to inclose a form of surrender, in duplicate, which you are hereby authorized to submit to the Indians under and in accordance with the provisions of the Indian Act. If the Indians consent to this surrender, you will be good enough to have it dated and executed by a number of them and witnessed by yourself and an affidavit of execution made on the form attached by yourself and a Chief and Principal Man before a Justice of the Peace or a Stipendiary Magistrate, and then return both documents to the Department for approval.
