

grounds leased to the St. Jean Flats

point in this boundary.

The expression "in a Northerly
direction," simply implies that the
position of Goose Lake was supposed
to be "Northerly" from the mouth of
Johnson's Lake. If on actual survey
the position of Goose Lake should be
found to be not "Northerly" it would
still be necessary to make Goose Lake
a point in the boundary, in the
same manner the mouth of Johnson's
Lake must be made a point in the
boundary.

Therefore an arbitrary line
running from the mouth of the out-
let from Johnson's Lake in a Northerly
direction
