Attawapiskat	June 22, 23, 24, 1960.

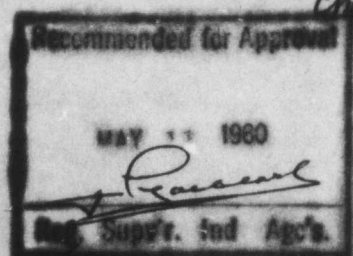
