



Sir,-

The firm state that they have mailed the Sterli Invoices and Bill of Lading to Messrs. Bell & Co. Customs Brokers, Winnipeg, with a request that the twine be passed and delivered to you as soon as possible after notice has been given by the Railway Company of their arrival.
