
Sir,

In reply to your letter of the 11th instant, and to the enclosed resolution of the Mississaugas of Mud Lake dealing with the subject of the dogs on the reserve, I have to say that it would appear that the Regulation as proposed is not within the powers of the Council of the Band to pass especially with regard to a levy of dog taxes and deduction from the interest money of the members of the Band.

A draft regulation is, however, enclosed which it is thought will meet the intention of the one proposed by the Council and which you will be good enough to have submitted for adoption.
