## Unemployed Benefits Provided by the Draft Bill

The attached memorandum submitted by the Honourable Ian Mackenzie deals with three aspects of the Draft Bill:

- 1. The arguments for and against a scale of fixed benefits proposed in the Draft Bill.
- 2. The possibility of applying the Act to members of the Armed Forces for the purpose of easing the burden of civil reestablishment.
- 3. A list of the types of employment excluded from the benefits of the Act. The memorandum calls attention to the fact that this list includes practically all the principal categories of employment in British Columbia.
