of all occupational groups during the war, if in the opinion of the Government such a measure will make stronger policies possible and increase the change of their acceptance;

(e) A holding of the cost of living index in the vicinity of its present level and the discontinuance of changes in the cost of living bonus for the future.

The Committee believes that acceptance of these recommendations will enable the Government to say that it has accepted substantially the Majority Report and to present to the public a strong and coherent program.
