the harnessing of atomic energy presents the world with an unparalleled opportunity to go forward into a brighter era than has ever been known before. Such is the promise and the reward of peace.

During the war, the Canadian people played an important part in meeting the challenge of world domination by Force. They are now equally prepared to play their full part in the endeavour to shape a new world order. It is the confident hope of the people of Canada that a world community may arise, enlightened by the conscience of free peoples, and maintained by the peaceful agencies of Reason, Justice and Good-will. In a world of co-operation and good-will, the peoples of all nations may hope to enjoy, in ever increasing measure, the fruits of man's new knowledge.

The victory two years ago over the forces of destruction manifested the existence of moral laws which inevitably link evil with disaster. The same laws continue to operate today. They are time enluring, and world perveding. Under the agencies of Reason, Justice and Good-will, they may be made, to cause the desert places of the world, to blossom as the rose.
