As pointed out before, the Councillors for this Band were elected for a three year term. As this expired on January 8th, they insisted on having a new Council elected. They were informed that they were elected under the indefinate system of the Indian Act, Section 97. The only further report that I can make in this matter is that these Indians are still anxious to be placed under the Advancement Section of the Indian Act as they claim that they were informed by the previous Agent that they were under the Act.
