(And it is to be observed, that clearing one half of the Road, and cutting down without clearing one chain in depth from the Road along the front of each Lot, shall be considered a part of the five acres per hundred required for settlement duty.) And upon his giving satisfactory proof of having performed the same, he will be entitled to receive a Grant to him and his heirs
