JUNE.—There is yet a good deal of manual labor and toil in a farm life, but certainly not what there was in the times past. Even the new townships are more accessible and the work of clearing up land not as laborious as in the early settlement of Canada. The improvements in modes of toil and the use of machinery are soon rendered possible, whereas the first settlers had to wait and receive the new inventions very gradually as they presented themselves. Now, also, our railway system enables a large proportion of the farmers of the country to diminish their manual labor and avail themselves of the use of machinery. It follows, therefore, that the agriculturist has greater opportunities of social comfort than in former times. There is much real pleasure in farm life.

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
