A Message from the Assembly by Mr. Bourdages, who being admitted, presented a Bill, the title of which he read in the French language only, and on being required by the Speaker to read the Title in English, as hath hitherto been the practice on such occasions, declared his incapacity so to do.

That this Subject be taken into confideration by a Committee of the whole House, on the next sitting day.

The Honorable Mr. Ryland presented two Messages from His Excellency the Administrator in Chief.

The Members rose, and the Messages were read in the words following:

The Administrator in Chief acquaints the Legislative Council, that representations having been made to him of distress prevailing to a very great degree in the Country Parishes, from the failure of the last Harvest, he directed the most accurate enquiry to be instituted in order to ascertain the fact.

The result of this investigation, contained in the accompanying document, the Administrator in Chief directed to be laid before the Legislative Council, recommending to them, should the subject be brought before their consideration, to concur in making provision for affording such relief as the case may appear to them to require.
