Refolved, That it appears to this Committee, that the Collector of Canfo, has during the laft Summer fuffered two Veffels belonging to the United States of America to take on board Cargoes of Fish, and granted them Permits to proceed with the fame, one to the Port of Bilboa, and the other to the Port of Lifbon in Europe.

Refolved, That it appears to the Committee that the Collector of Canfo has received from a Number of American Vessels for their Entry or Clearance in that Port, three Pounds each, and also fix Shillings and cight Pence for Anchorage, for each American Vessel coming into the faid Harbour.

The above Report was agreed to by the Houfe, and the Solicitor General moved, that a Copy of the Report should be delivered to His Excellency the Governor by a Committee of this House, who should be instructed to pray His Excellency would take the same into Confideration.

Ordered accordingly, and Mr. Wallace, the Solicitor General and Mr. Cochran, were appointed for that Purpofe.

The Houfe directed them at the fame Time they prefented the Report, to reprefent to His Excellency the prefent inconvenient and very detached Situations of the Cuftom Houfe and Impost and Excise Offices in the Suburbs of *Halifax*, and to request those Offices might be kept in Places more convenient for the Trade.

The Order of the Day being called for,

Mr. Craze moved, That the Houfe fhould not now proceed on the Confideration of the Government Estimate, but should proceed on the Confideration of the Repair of Roads, which being put, passed in the affirmative.

The House then proceeded to take into Confideration the Repair of Roads in different Parts of the Province and thereupon,

Refolved, That a Sum of Fifteen Hundred Pounds be granted and applied for the Purpose of opening Roads from Halifax to Shelburne, and from thence to Yarmouth.

Resolved, That of the above Sum Two Hundred and Fifty Pounds shall be appropriated for making the Road between Yarmouth and Shelburne.

That Five Hundred Pounds shall be appropriated for making the Road between Shelburne and Liverpool.

That Two Hundred and Fifty Pounds shall be appropriated for making the Road between Liverpool and Lunenburg.

That two Hundred and Fifty Pounds shall be appropriated for making the Road between Lunenburg, and Halifax.

That two Hundred and Fifty Pounds be appropriated for making the Road from Halifax towards Lunnenburg.

And that the fame shall be paid to such Commissioners as His Excellency the Governor may be pleased to appoint in faid Townships respectively, to be by them laid out and expended for Purposes aforesaid.

Refolved, That the Sum of one Hundred Pounds be granted and applied

Agreed to by the Houfe, and Committee appointed to pray His Excellency would take the fame into Confideration.
