The Council defire a present Conference with this House, by Committee, on the subject of the several Resolutions respecting Hemp, in the Committee Room of the Council.

Ordered, That the Clerk do acquaint the Council with the foregoing Refolution.

Mr. Wallace reported, That the Committee had been at the Conference, and flated the fuftance of the fame to the House.

The Council have agreed to the Five feveral Refolutions of this House, for granting Monies to encourage the growth of Hemp.

And then the Meffenger withdrew.

On Motion, the House resolved itself into a Committee to confider further of a Supply, to be granted for the Support of His Majesty's Government.

Mr. Speaker left the Chair,

Mr. Sargent took the Chair,

Mr. Speaker refumed the Chair.

The Chairman reported from the Committeee, that they had gone through the Bulinefs to them referred, and that the Committee had come to feveral Refolutions thereupon, on which they had framed a Bill for applying certain Monies therein mentioned, for the Service of the year 1801, and for appropriating fuch part of the Supplies granted this Selfion of General Affembly, as are not already appropriated by the Laws or Acts of the Province, to be delivered to the Houle, and he read the Report in his place, and afterwards delivered the Bill in at the Clerk's Table, where the Refolutions and Claufes therein contained, were feverally read throughout a first and fecond time, and upon the Queftion put thereupon, agreed to by the Houle.

On Motion, the Bill for applying certain Monies for the Service of the year 1801, and for appropriating fuch part of the Supplies granted in this Seffion of General Affembly, as are not already appropriated by the Laws or Acts of the Province, was read a first time.

Refolved, That the Bill be now read a fecond time, and the fame was read accordingly.
