An ACT to prevent Defertion from his Majefty's Regular Forces, by granting a Bounty for Apprehending Deferters in this Province.

[Paffed 6th March, 1812,]

THEREAS from the local fituation of this Province, fome further provision than the general Laws of the Empire afford, is necessary for the encouragement of perfons who apprehend Deferters ; Be it therefore enacted by the King's most excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Affembly of the Province of Upper Canada, conflituted and affembled by virtue of and under the authority of an A& paffed in the Parliament of Grea.
