

Several Bills were introduced, and motions for papers given. The enquiry of Mr. Gillespie whether it was the intention of the Government, in the present depressed state of the trade, to reduce the rate of stamp duty, and if so, when a new seal will be put in force, was ruled out of order.

FRIDAY, April 4. In the afternoon, the House went in Committee on Supply. The discussion of the appropriation of \$80,000 for the completion of the bridge, was resumed.

Mr. Blair censured the management of the Board of Works Department in the matter of contracts for bridges, asserting that the bridge building was in the hands of a ring, and citing the cases of the Tabularium, St. Andrew's, and Ferris's Point bridges.
