ABOUT THE VISIT.

It is a rule of the Presbyterian Church that one year in eight the missionary in a foreign land is allowed to return home and remain for a time and recruit, and renew old friendships and the like. Dr. McKay will probably remain for some months in his native Canada, but intends then to return to the fields of his great life work. Arrangements for the education of his children here will probably he made during that time, His native helper will also return to Formosa, He is naturally much attached to Canada and his native county, and the people of Oxford are much interested in his success in his grand work. During his former visit, eleven years ago, the people of the county contributed nearly \$7,000 to assist in the establishment of Oxford College in Formosa, where numbers of the young are now being educated and trained. This time he made the trip in a little less than a month, and the party seemed but little fatigued when they landed last evening at Woodstock. In his former trip home it was necessary to come by way of the Red Sea and England, and nearly six months were taken in the journey, including a visit to Palestine and Egypt. They can well appreciate the advantages of our newly established Canadian ronte across the Pacific as well as across this continent, even though they fail to appreciate the "civility" for our present customs officers. It is to be hoped that our Government will see to it that no such outrages shall ever occur again.
