LONDON'S GREAT STRIKE.

The strike is still at a deadlock. The representatives of the companies are preparing a manifesto in which they will declare that they will only pay fivepence per hour. The 'Leigraph, Construction and Maintenanea Company's workmen at Greenwich have struck. The tailors are joining the strikers.

London, Aug. 29.—The great s'rike reached its crisis last night when the dock companies rolused the final compromise offered by the men. It now remains to be seen whether John Burns, the socialist leader, will be able to restrain the fury of 100,000 hungry men goaded to a point of desperation by the misery of their starving families for another week. If this is possible, and it would be impossible under any other leader, it is the general opinion that the dock companies will be obliged to give in. If Burns loses control of the strikers there may follow the bloodiest riot ever known. Men are gathered by tens of thousands along the river front. Their aspect is gloomy and sullen. Many thousands have not tasted food for a day, and to return to their houses means that they will be obliged to listen to the origs of their story of their structure.
