creation and His own creatures received Him not," no improvements on the authorized version. A very distinct bird's eye view is given of recent exploration in Palestine, and a sympathetic review of the new Methodist Hymn Book, which seems to be, on the whole, the best ever published. The Prince of Wales and his advisers come in for some whole some criticism in connection with the royal visit to India. A masterly

paper traces the term "elders" through the New Testament, and establishes the actual and relative importance of the office indicated. A review of Robinson's "Mother of Jesus, not the Papal Mary," traces with skill the growth of Mariolatry. An article of great beauty and fine artistic discrimination, discusses Leonardo da Vinci, his works, and the wonderful age in which he lived.
