

dollars. Payments for transit through locks in Canada only shall be made in Canadian dollars, and payments for transit through locks in the United States only shall be paid in United States dollars.

- (4) The tolls for transit of the Welland Canal shall be paid in Canadian dollars and shall accrue to the Authority.

Security for Payment

4. The representative of each vessel shall provide the Authority with security, satisfactory to the Authority, for payment of tolls.

Description and Weight of Cargo

5. (1) A cord of pulpwood shall be deemed to weigh 3,200 pounds.
- (2) (a) 1,000 f.b.m. of sawn softwood lumber with less than 15 per cent moisture content shall be deemed to weigh 1,700 pounds;
- (b) 1,000 f.b.m. of sawn softwood lumber with 15 per cent moisture content or over shall be deemed to weigh 2,100 pounds;
- (c) 1,000 f.b.m. of sawn hardwood lumber with less than 15 per cent moisture content shall be deemed to weigh 2,500 pounds;
- (d) 1,000 f.b.m. of sawn hardwood lumber with 15 per cent moisture content or over shall be deemed to weigh 3,100 pounds;
- (3) The tonnage used in the assesment of tolls shall be calculated to the nearest 2,000 pounds.
