- 2. If the competent institution of one Party requires that a beneficiary who resides in the territory of the other Party undergo an additional medical examination, the liaison agency of the latter Party, at the request of the liaison agency of the first Party, will make arrangements for carrying out this examination according to the rules applied by the liaison agency making the said arrangements and at the expense of the agency which requests the medical examination.
- 3. The amounts due as a result of applying the provisions of paragraph 2 of this Article will be reimbursed without delay on receipt of a detailed statement of the costs incurred.

## ARTICLE 9

The liaison agencies of the Parties, with the consent of the respective competent authorities, will agree on the forms necessary to implement the Convention and this Administrative Arrangement.

## ARTICLE 10

The liaison agencies of the Parties will exchange statistics on an annual basis, and in a form to be agreed upon, regarding the payments which each has made under the Convention. These statistics will include data on the number of beneficiaries and the total amount of benefits paid, by type of benefit.

## ARTICLE 11

This Administrative Arrangement will take effect on the date of entry into force of the Convention and will have the same period of duration.
