That it is expedient to introduce a measure to authorize grants of assistance to provinces for the conservation of water resources under the terms and conditions specified in the said measure, such grants not to exceed thirtyseven and one-half per cent of the projects and to be paid out of moneys appropriated by Parliament for the abovementioned purposes; and to provide that all officers, clerks and employees required for carrying out the provisions of the measure shall be appointed in accordance with the provisions of the Civil Service Act.

Whereupon, Mr. Winters, a Member of the Queen's Privy Council, informed the House, That His Excellency the Governor General, having been informed of the subject-matter of the said proposed Resolution, recommends it to the House.

Resolved, That the House do go into Committee of the Whole at the next sitting of the House to consider the said proposed Resolution.

Mr. Winters moved,—That the House do go into Committee of the Whole at the next sitting of the House to consider the following proposed Resolution:—

That it is expedient to provide for the establishment of the Historic Sites and Monuments Board of Canada on a statutory basis; to provide that the Board shall consist of twelve members and for its powers and duties; to provide also that the appointed members shall be paid a fee for attending each meeting and travelling and living expenses incurred in connection with the business of the Board; to provide also for the appointment and remuneration of a secretary of the Board; and to provide further that all expenditures for the purposes of the Act shall be paid out of moneys appropriated by Parliament therefor.

Whereupon, Mr. Winters, a Member of the Queen's Privy Council, informed the House, That His Excellency the Governor General, having been informed of the subject-matter of the said proposed Resolution, recommends it to the House.

Resolved, That the House do go into Committee of the Whole at the next sitting of the House to consider the said proposed Resolution.

Mr. Howe moved,—That the House do go into Committee of the Whole at the next sitting of the House to consider the following proposed Resolution:—

That it is expedient to introduce a measure to amend The Trans-Canada Air Lines Act, 1937, to provide that the Corporation shall be under the management of a Board of Directors composed of nine persons in lieu of seven; to increase the powers of the Corporation, and to adjust its capital structure in such a way as to conform to normal commercial practice.

Whereupon, Mr. Howe, a Member of the Queen's Privy Council, informed the House, That His Excellency the Governor General, having been informed of the subject-matter of the said proposed Resolution, recommends it to the House.

Resolved, That the House do go into Committee of the Whole at the next sitting of the House to consider the said proposed Resolution.
