I would like to have more time to go behind the reasons that motivated the statement of Mr. Speaker Macdonald on the very next day after making a ruling.

I would ask the house to go along with the suggestion that I have often made that the amendment be modified by unanimous consent, so that we do not have a dispute on the point of an amendment respecting third reading of the bill giving instructions to reconsider a money clause in a money bill which must necessitate a money resolution at the time of introduction and must be moved by a minister of the crown. I see no reason why the house cannot agree to have the amendment simply read that the bill be referred back for the purpose of reconsidering subclause 2, clause 6, because any member has the right to change a word, or a comma into a colon or a semicolon. therefore I do not think if the house should agree to have the wording of the amendment changed in that manner, that the point with respect to the financial initiative of the crown would be involved in any way whatsoever. Of course that is left to the unanimous consent of the house. If the house does not wish to give unanimous consent I would not at the moment feel prepared to declare the amendment out of order. Does the house agree that the amendment be changed so as to read that this bill be not now read a third time but that it be referred back to the committee of the whole house for the purpose of reconsidering subclause 2 of clause 6 of the said
