- (f) for the second reading of a bill.
- (2) A like notice is required of any inquiry not relating to a bill or other matter appearing among the Orders of the Day or on the Order Paper.

One day's notice of certain motions

- 45. (1) One day's notice shall be given of any of the following motions:
 - (a) to suspend any rule or any part thereof;
 - (b) for the third reading of a bill;
 - (c) for any substantial amendment to a bill reported by a committee;
 - (d) for the appointment of a standing committee;
 - (e) for an instruction to a committee;
 - (f) for the adoption of a report from any standing committee;
 - (g) for an adjournment of the Senate, other than the ordinary daily adjournment under Rule 46(r) or that under Rules 13, 36(1), 46(f), 46(g);
 - (h) for the making of a substantive motion;
 - (i) for any purpose to which neither Rule 44 nor Rule 46 applies.
- (2) Where a senator wishes to correct irregularities or mistakes in an order, resolution, or other vote of the Senate, the senator shall give one day's notice, and a correction shall not be made unless at least two-thirds of the senators present vote in favour of such correction.

Motions for which no notice required

- **46.** No notice is required of the following motions:
- (a) by way of amendment to a question;
